Privacy Policy

We may make changes to this policy from time to time and will notify you on the site when we do. New versions will never apply retroactively; we will tell you the exact date they go into effect. If you keep using AdventureMakers, that means you accept the policy.

Who we are

We create a funding platform for people who want to create spaces for adventure.

How this Policy Applies

This policy describes the information we collect from you, how we use it and why. It also covers whether and how that information may be shared and your rights regarding the information you provide to us. By using the Services offered by AdventureMakers, you are acknowledging you have agreed to our Terms of Use and that you have read and understood this privacy policy, including our cookie policy.

What we collect and Receive

In order to create an account and use our services, we need to collect and use certain information. Depending on your use of our services, that may include:

- Information you provide by completing forms on AdventureMakers. This may include your name, email address, postal addresses, telephone number, country of residence, login and password details. We may ask for this information if you register as a user of our services, upload or submit content through AdventureMakers or if you contact us
- Information that you provide to AdventureMakers for identify verification when launching a project. This information may include your legal name, business name, Tax ID for business entities and date of birth.
- AdventureMakers partners with other companies for payment processing. Details of any requests or transactions you make through our services will be tracked by AdventureMakers. The payment information you submit is collected and used by these third parties in accordance with their privacy policy. AdventureMakers does not store your payment information apart from the last four digits of your credit card or bank account, expiration date, and country, which we require for tax, government regulatory, and security purposes.
- Information about your activity on and interaction with AdventureMakers.
- Information about the ways people visit and interact with AdventureMakers, in the form of traffic analytics. You can choose to opt out of being included in Google Analytics.
- Communications you send to us
- Information that you submit on AdventureMakers

Of course, at any time you may choose to not provide us with your information. However, this will severely limit your ability to use AdventureMakers services.

How We Use this information

- To keep your account secure and protect our services
- To enable us to provide you with our services, and to both improve and promote our services
- To create and administer your account, contact you and customize your experience
- To track and analyze use of AdventureMakers

How This Information is Shared

Information that is shared publicly

As a project sponsor, when you create an account with us we may create a profile page that will be available to the public. The profile will include information such as your business name, address, validating information, pictures, etc. It will also include projects you have sponsored, partners in the projects, etc.

Information that is not shared publicly

- Payment information
- Password details
- IP address
- Phone Number
- Date of Birth
- Any information specifically marked as 'private'
- Communications you send to us directly

Information that is shared with third parties

We may share your information with certain third-party services. An example of this is third-party payment services. When we share data with third-party services that support our services, we require that they use your information only for the purposes we've authorized. We also require that they protect your information at least to the standards that we do.

Information that is shared with creators/sponsors

When you back a project, the sponsor will know your username and the dollar amount. Sponsors will never receive any information on your payment information. They will also receive the email address associated with your account. Project sponsors may choose to send you communication related to the project or future projects. You may opt out of this communication by contacting us at AdventureMakers.

Project sponsors are required to keep your information confidential. They should never request any sensitive information such as a social security number or payment information.

Information that is shared to help us comply with the law

We reserve the right to share information when we feel it is necessary to comply with the law or law enforcement, to prevent abuse or fraud, or to protect our legal rights or safety.

Links to other sites or services.

Our site may include links to other websites or services whose privacy practices are not the same. When you use a link to one of these external sites or services, you are then governed by the privacy policy and practices of that site or service.

Retention

We will keep your information indefinitely. If you wish to have your information removed and your account deactivated, you must contact us.

Data Transfers

AdventureMakers is a US based company and your information will be collected and processed in the United States. AdventureMakers is not intended for individuals outside of the United States. If you choose to use the services, you need to agree to our Terms of use.

Your Rights

All users can manage your personal information in their account settings. You can also request a downloadable copy of your personal data by sending an email to AdventureMakers. You may also delete your account at any time. We may retain certain information as required by law or as necessary for our legitimate business purposes.

Email and Mobile Notifications

You have the option to opt out of any marketing emails sent by AdventureMakers.

Security

We take security seriously. The security of your personal data is very important to us. We follow industry-standard practices to protect the data we collect and maintain. This includes encrypting information as it travels over the internet. However, no information is completely secure and we cannot guarantee it is absolutely secure. Your account is protected by a password, which you should choose carefully and keep secure.

Children

People under 18 are not permitted to use AdventureMakers on their own. .
